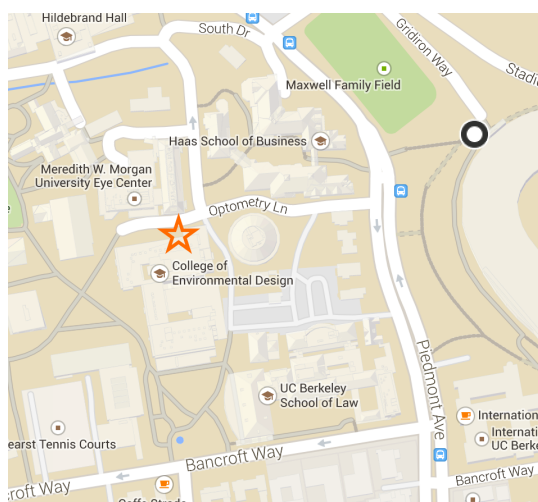

The Society of California archivists sponsors meetings which disseminate information about archival collections, issues, and methodology to the profession and the public.

This day-long workshop is a crash-course in conceptualizing, creating, and evaluating exhibits. It covers:

Assessing available resources

Managing timelines and goals

Designing a compelling story and practical tips on how to tell it visually and textually

Basic design principles; and

Collections handling, care, and documentation.

The afternoon portion of the workshop is a small-group exercise in creating your own exhibit. Participants are encouraged to bring a list of objects they'd like to exhibit.
